School based model / Apprenticeship model

School based VET: minimum 24 weeks incompany training

- School is responsible for the execution
- Students are enrolled in school, incompany training organised by school
- Financial and non-financial aid for companies

Apprenticeship VET: more than 50% in company training

- Shared responsibility between school and company
- Company selects the student and signs the learning contract
- Defined minimal financial reward
- Chambers' role reinforced
- Financial and non-financial aid for companies

NATIONAL LEVEL

Catalogue of practical training: prepared for employers, clearly defines learning outcomes, basis for planning and execution of formative assessment

COMPANY / SCHOOL LEVEL

Work based learning plan for each student

FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT

Communication between student, mentor and teacher; continuous evaluation of student's work and monitoring the student's progress

SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT:

Based on each module assessment plan is prepared

Intermediate assessment : monitoring of student's progress, executed by chambers

FINAL ASSESSMENT: 2 parts, slovene language and assessment of a service or product (execution and oral examination)
