

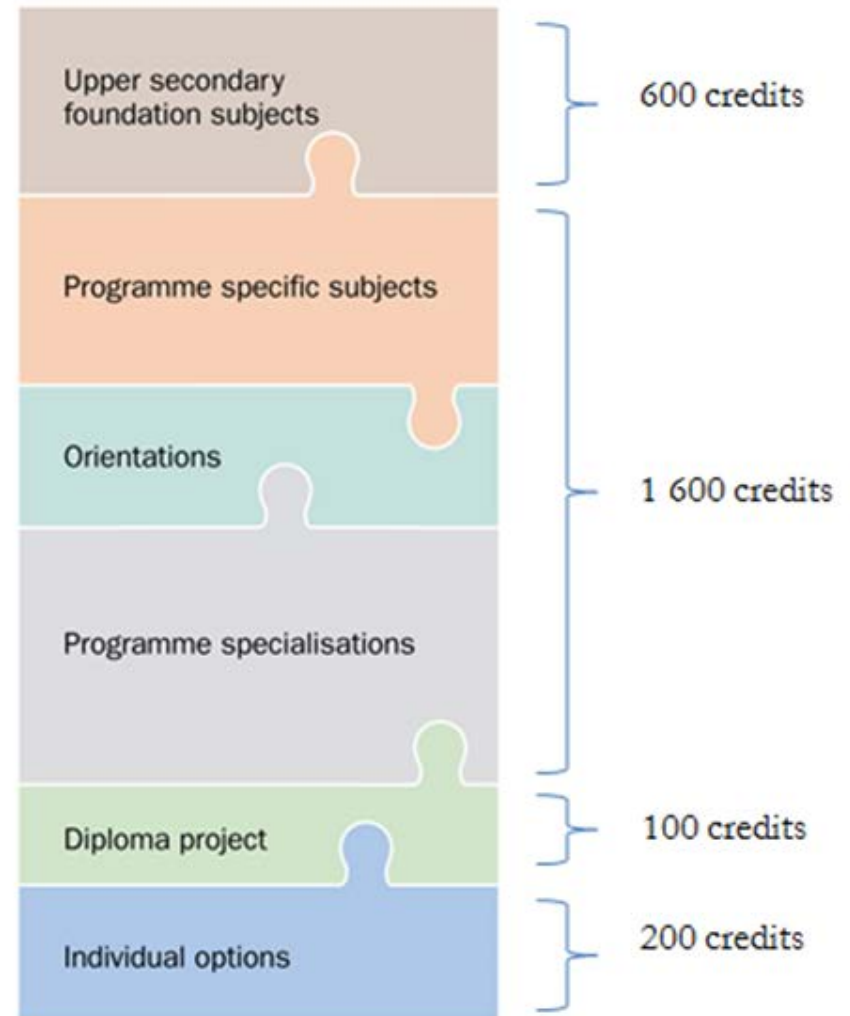


VET packages

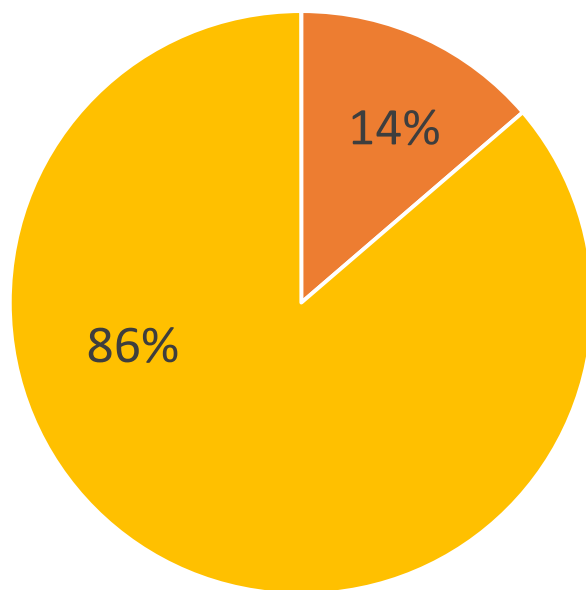
ECVET Annual Forum 2017

- A VET programme takes 2430 hours, covers 3 years, is counted in 2500 points.
- Courses: 50 to 200 points.
- Relative weight of one 100-point course = 4%
- The learning is assessed and documented in grades.
- Grades provide credits that can be accumulated and transferred.

Vocational programmes

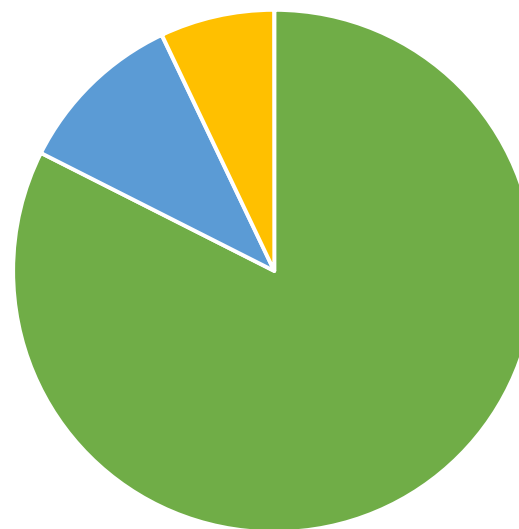


Share of learners beginning upper secondary education in 2013 that changed programme.



■ Changed ■ Not changed

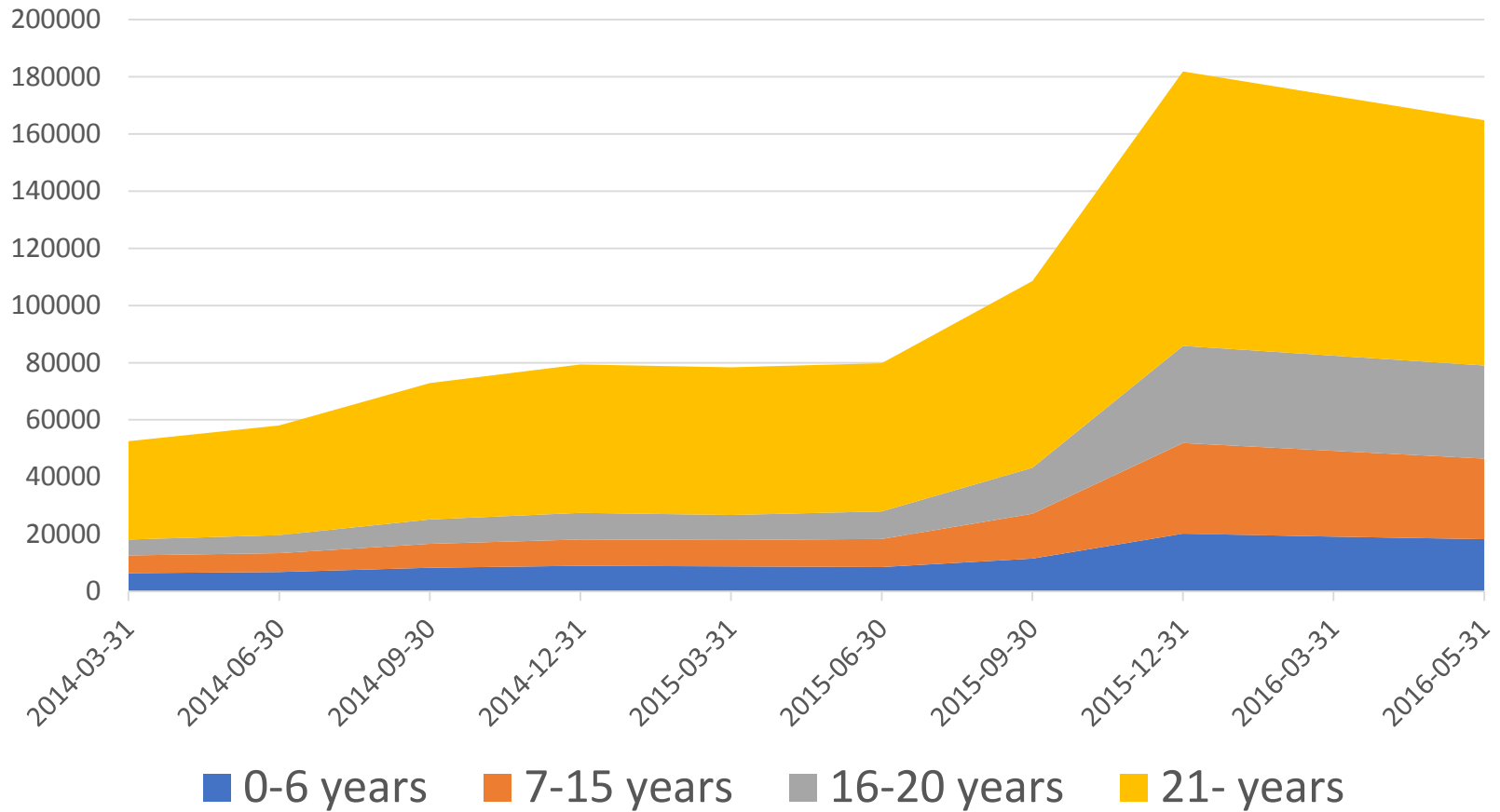
Share of upper secondary learners in Introduction -- not eligible for a national programme.

Newly arrived immigrants

Context

- Many learners are not eligible for admission to upper secondary education – almost 17% of the age cohort in 2016.
- Many learners do not complete upper secondary education / a full qualification.
- High levels of newly arrived immigrants.
- Ambition to lower unemployment rates.
- Shortage of qualified labour.

VET packages

- Adult education.
- Introduction programmes (youth not eligible for upper secondary school).
- Identification of courses [units] that can lead to partial qualifications which later can be accumulated and lead to full qualifications.
- Packages will be presented to the Government in December.
