Key objectives

Short-term

- ★ Experiment long-stay European mobility for apprentices (6-12 months)
- ★ Identify obstacles and find solutions

Mid-term

- ★ Put in place a European Framework for the Mobility of Apprentices

Key figures

- ★ **2 projects** (*European Apprenticeship Ambassadors, European Apprenticeship Ambassadors – Go Further*)
- ★ **36 partners**
- ★ **12 countries** (*Belgium, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Hungary, Italy, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Spain*)
- ★ **80 departures between August 2016 & January 2018** (*apprentices and post-apprentices*)
- ★ **45 hosting companies**

Profile of participants

- ★ 17 to 26 years old
- ★ Status in the country of origin:
 - 9 apprentices, 2 students
 - 69 just graduated
- ★ 25 trades, 9 sectors
- ★ 84 % level 3 and 4 EQF

- ★ In July 2017, 63,3 % partners willing to use ECVET
