What is “Torno Subito”?

“Torno Subito” (TS) is a Programme promoted by the Regione Lazio - Department of Education, Research, School Education and Universities- financed by the ROP Lazio ESF 2014-2020 Axis III “Education and Training” (Investment Priority 10.ii - Specific Objective, 10.5).

Laziodisu (Organization for the Right to Higher Education in Lazio) is in charge for the implementation of the Initiative.

What are the goals of “Torno Subito”?

The Initiative is aimed at:

- strengthening and improving the human capital of young people by encouraging the mobility in Europe and abroad;

In the last edition (2017) the 56.8% of the Recipients decided to implement abroad part of the project

- creating opportunities for the development of professional networks, both in Italy and abroad;

The network of Torno Subito counts about 4.000 partners

- contributing in reducing the gap between the demand and supply of work by allowing youth to build a professional profile able to respond to:
 - their dreams and expectations
 - the needs of the Italian and European labour market

At the end of the project 36% of the Recipients is working in Italy or abroad; 12% of the Recipients receives a job offer during the implementation of the project

How does “Torno Subito” work?

“Torno Subito” funds individual projects.

The projects must be implemented in two phases:

PHASE 1 - to be carried out outside the Lazio region (in other Italian regions, EU countries, other European and non-European countries) in order to acquire knowledge, skills and professional abilities through training activities or work experiences (internships, training on the job, research activities).

PHASE 2 – to be implemented within the Lazio region, aimed at redeploying the skills and knowledge acquired in Phase 1, through work experiences, start-up projects or research activities.

How does “Torno Subito” promote the mobility? Recognizing additional scores to the individual projects implemented in foreign countries.

Who are the partners of “Torno Subito”?

The 58% of our international network is represented by public and private universities, schools and research institutes where the Recipients attend a master or a course.

The remaining 42% implements a work experience in:

- Private enterprises
- Public institutions (hospitals, schools, museums, theatres, Ministries, Regions, Municipalities,...)
- Non-profit organisations (L&INGOs, foundations, charity organisations,...)
- Coworking spaces and shared offices

For the VET projects the hosting partners are usually culinary academies and Hotel Management schools for the training activities; restaurants and hotels for the work experiences.

Who can submit the project proposal?

The Proposers are both Italian or foreigner citizens, resident in Lazio for at least 6 months, aged between 18 and 35, young unemployed or *first-time jobseekers* and with the following requirements:

- university students *or*
- university graduates *or*
- secondary school graduates – **only for Cinema and Food&Wine sectors**
- VET students who completed the 3-year course in “Education and Professional Training” - **only for the Food&Wine sector**

The VET students are girls (34%) and boys (66%), aged from 18 years old, who chose to acquire the 3-year certificate in Hotel Management/Culinary schools in order to start to work instead to get a 5-year diploma.

The average age is 24 years; the 90% of the Recipients decided to attend a training course in the first Phase of the project.

Eligible costs

PHASE 1

- lump sum for food, accommodation and travel costs according to the Lazio Region regulations
- contribution for the cost of the training course:
 - maximum € 3,500.00 for courses lasting between 1 and 3 months
 - maximum € 7,000.00 for courses lasting between 3 months + 1 day and 6 months
- or*
- monthly allowance for the work experience outside the Lazio region: € 800.00 gross per month
- health insurance up to a maximum of € 500.00
- services for assistance for persons with disabilities up to a maximum of € 8,000.00

PHASE 2

- monthly allowance of € 800.00 gross for the work experience and research activity
- monthly allowance of € 800.00 gross for the guided pathway to self-employment in the coworking spaces and shared offices

The past “Torno Subito” editions: some data

148 girls and boys are currently implementing their projects within the VET component.

This component was experimented for the first time in 2017 with a specific Call for Proposal, “Torno Subito Gusto 2017”.

Obstacles to the mobility:

- Knowledge of foreign languages (15% of the Recipients go abroad to study a new language)
- Difficulty to identify the hosting partner of the 1st Phase of the project

Lessons learnt:

- To build an effective network of international partners
- To use a youth friendly language (Call for Proposal in accessible and understandable language; on-line platform for the submission of the proposal and management of the individual project; promotion and communication through social networks such as Facebook, You Tube and Instagram)
